

Aswan to Luxor (5 Nights / 6 Days)

Journey through the heart of ancient Egypt on a classic Nile voyage. This itinerary blends awe-inspiring temple visits with the tranquil rhythm of river life, taking you from the modern engineering marvels of Aswan to the monumental wonders of Luxor.

- **Tips for Your Trip:** This itinerary involves significant walking at archaeological sites, often on uneven ground. Comfortable shoes, sun protection, and water are essential. The sailing schedule and overnight mooring locations are subject to change based on river and lock conditions

Day 1: Aswan – Embarkation & City Highlights

- **Arrival & Boarding:** Embark your cruise ship in Aswan. Settle into your cabin and enjoy lunch on board.
- **Afternoon Tour:** Explore key sites in Aswan:
 - **Philae Temple:** A beautiful temple complex dedicated to the goddess Isis, relocated to Agilkia Island.
 - **The High Dam:** The monumental engineering feat that created Lake Nasser.
 - **The Old Dam:** The original Aswan Dam, built by the British in 1902.
 - **The Unfinished Obelisk:** A glimpse into ancient stone-working techniques at the granite quarries.
- **Evening:** Dinner and your first night at leisure, moored in Aswan.

Day 2: Abu Simbel Option & Sailing to Kom Ombo

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- **Morning Choice (Optional):**
 - **Option A:** An early morning excursion (by plane or convoy) to the breathtaking **Temples of Abu Simbel**, built by Ramses II.
 - **Option B:** A more relaxed morning visiting **Aswan's Botanical Gardens (Kitchener's Island)** and a traditional **Nubian Village**.
- **Afternoon Sail:** Begin your cruise northward.
- **Late Afternoon Visit:** Disembark to explore the unique **Temple of Kom Ombo**, dedicated to both the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon god Horus.
- **Evening Sail:** Continue sailing to the mooring site near Edfu.
- **Overnight:** Moored near Edfu.

Day 3: Edfu Temple & Onward to El Kab

- **Morning Visit:** Travel by horse-drawn carriage to the immensely well-preserved **Temple of Edfu**, dedicated to the god Horus.
- **Midday Sail:** Cruise towards the ancient site of El Kab.
- **Afternoon:** Enjoy the passing river scenery from the sundeck.
- **Overnight:** Moored near El Kab.

Day 4: El Kab & Sailing to Luxor via Esna

- **Morning Visit:** Explore the archaeological site of **El Kab**, an ancient city with tombs, temples, and rock inscriptions.
- **Midday Sail:** Cruise towards Luxor, passing through the **Esna Lock**(where you can observe the process from deck) and past the town of Esna.
- **Evening Arrival:** Arrive in Luxor in the evening.
- **Overnight:** Moored in Luxor.

Day 5: Luxor – Thebes, City of the Gods

- **Morning Tour (West Bank):** Cross the Nile to explore the **Theban Necropolis**, including the **Valley of the Kings** (entry to 3 tombs), the **Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir el-Bahari**, and the towering **Colossi of Memnon**.
- **Afternoon Tour (East Bank):** Discover the magnificent **Karnak Temple Complex**, the largest religious site in the world. Later, visit the elegant **Luxor Temple**, beautifully lit at dusk.
- **Evening:** Farewell dinner and final night on board in Luxor.
